The Galician Chamber Orchestra, conducted by Maestro Rogelio Groba Otero, will perform works by Handel, W. A. Mozart, Edvard Grieg, and Rogelio Groba himself, in a programme that combines universal repertoire with contemporary composition by Galicia's most prominent and prolific composer.
